This feature extends the capabilities of the **“Financier” profile**, allowing **financial institutions**, such as banks, green funds, and public financing bodies to:

- **Publish** their financing products directly on the platform
- **Detail** terms, eligibility criteria, and requirements
- **Increase** the visibility of funding tools
- **Get matched** with relevant renovation projects

BANKS

Bankers are users who want to finance energy efficiency projects in buildings.

Use the platform to:

- Promote financing products tailored to energy efficiency projects (e.g., green loans, mortgages)
- Specify eligible building types, investment ranges, and supported technologies
- Receive notifications when Building Owners or Public Bodies express interest in your financing tools
- Evaluate pre-qualified projects with structured data on CAPEX, IRR, payback, and KPIs
- Set matchmaking filters to prioritize projects that meet your investment criteria
- Access user-validated project pipelines to identify scalable investment opportunities
- Monitor engagement with your products and track financed project performance



How It Works

1. **Financiers upload** their financing schemes and specify their criteria.
2. **Project owners** – including public bodies – browse the available options.
3. When a match occurs, **financiers are instantly notified**, enabling quick follow-up and support.

This **user-driven matchmaking** dramatically simplifies access to tailored financial solutions, making it easier than ever to fund building renovations and energy upgrades.

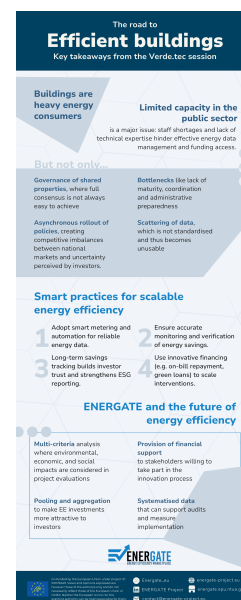

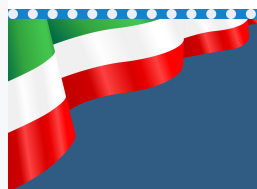
Highlights from CLIMA 2025 Workshop

On June 5, 2025, at Politecnico di Milano's Campus Bovisa during [CLIMA2025](#), stakeholders from the real estate, energy, and finance sectors gathered for a joint ENERGATE and MODERATE workshop, organised by REHVA. The session focused on innovative solutions for improving energy efficiency in buildings and scaling up investments in building renovation.

The workshop featured a presentation by Katerina Papapostolou (NTUA), who outlined ENERGATE's strategy to unlock finance for sustainable renovation. By introducing innovative financial mechanisms and engaging key market players, ENERGATE aims to reduce investment risks and facilitate access to funding for energy efficiency projects. Csaba de Csiky (ESC) also contributed valuable insights during the panel discussion.

Key takeaways included:

- Growing interest from real estate asset managers, tempered by concerns around upfront costs and return on investment
- Investor perspectives highlight the importance of clear value propositions and aggregated project pipelines to attract private capital
- The need for alignment with the Energy Performance of Buildings Directive (EPBD) and standardized data collection to build trust and scale investments



Key Takeaways from ENERGATE Workshop in Budapest



Key Takeaways from ENERGATE Regional Training Workshop in Budapest

On **June 30, 2025, in Budapest**, the **ENERGATE 4th Regional Training Workshop** convened energy, finance, and policy stakeholders to tackle barriers in residential energy renovation.

Key points:

- Strong market interest, but low implementation capacity, worsened by low energy prices and underestimated homeowner benefits.
- Barriers: fragmented responsibilities, GDPR data limits, and small unbankable projects.
- Solutions: ENERGATE Platform aggregates projects, provides AI-driven local decision tools, and builds “one-stop shops” to attract EU support.
- Investors stressed the need for bundled projects (€25M+), standardized documentation, and crowdfunding for household savings.
- The **ENERGATE Declaration** urged digital platforms as core tools in PPPs, backed by stable policies and innovation.
- Long-term: evolve into a self-sustained platform aligned with EU frameworks (Taxonomy, EPBD, EPC registers) with international replication goals.

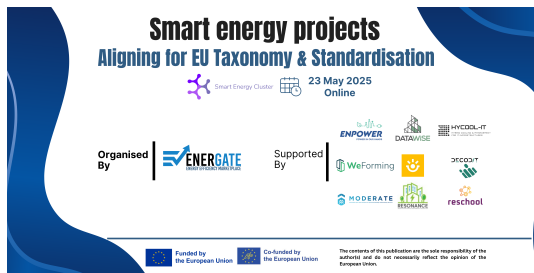

Project Manager **Katerina Papapostolou** presented ENERGATE's approach to enabling energy-efficiency investments and engaged with stakeholders working on climate, environment, and sustainable development under the LIFE programme. ENERGATE at EEITE 2025

On 4–6 June 2025, the ENERGATE participated with 2 papers in [6th International Conference in Electronic Engineering and Information Technology](#). The first paper, titled "**ML-Based Decision Support System for Energy Efficiency Retrofits**", was presented by Daniela Stoian (NTUA) and proposed a machine learning-based system that uses data from past renovation projects to recommend optimal retrofit actions tailored to individual buildings. The second paper, "**Assessing Investment Risks in Energy Efficiency Projects Using AHP for**



Group Decision Making," was presented by Ioanna Andreoulaki (NTUA) and introduced a multicriteria approach based on the Analytic Hierarchy Process (AHP) to identify and prioritise key risks in energy efficiency investments, supporting stakeholder collaboration and improving financing decisions. ENERGATE at EU Taxonomy & Standardisation Workshop

On 23 May 2025, the ENERGATE project hosted an online workshop focused on the integration of the EU Taxonomy for sustainable activities and the role of standardisation in supporting

climate, energy, and digital transitions. The event brought together representatives from ten EU-funded projects—**DECODIT, Hycool_it, DEDALUS, RESONANCE, ENPOWER, Weforming, MODERATE, DATAWISE, RESCHOOL, and ENERGATE**—to exchange experiences, identify shared challenges, and explore practical approaches to interpreting and applying these frameworks. Discussions highlighted the growing importance of aligning project activities with the EU Taxonomy and relevant standards, both to improve sustainability performance and to meet evolving regulatory and financing requirements. 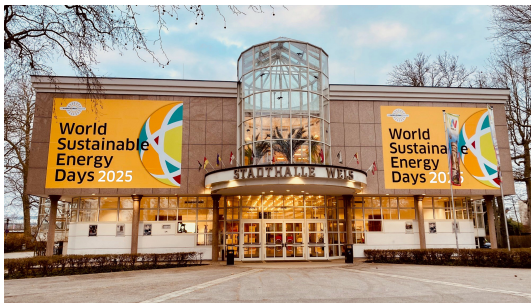
